Currently serves as Chairman, ESNA Holdings Group in Sri Lanka, and as a Director at Renuka Hotel Colombo, Movenpick Colombo and Centara Ceysands Resort & Spa in Bentota, Sri Lanka.

Charles Nanayakkara

With the end of World War 2 in 1945, and the uptick in leisure travel, the Late Charles Nanayakkara had a vision to connect Sri Lanka to the World. Hence with a leap of faith he expanded his thriving inland trucking and logistics business and incorporated Ceylon Carriers (Travel Services) Ltd in 1973. Further given Sri Lanka's prime location in the Indian Ocean, connecting the West and East, the Late Charles Nanayakkara saw the potential in inbound & outbound travel / tour services, and went on to earn Pioneer status in Sri Lanka's Travel and Tourism Industry. His legacy was then passed on to his Son Mr. Udaya Nanayakkara in 1981.



Popular Destinations

ANURADHAPURA

Anuradhapura has been considered by historians, archaeologists, travelers and tourists as the most important cultural city in Sri Lanka. Recognized travel guides state that every international tourist to South Asia should visit Anuradhapura, which is one of the first World Heritage sites declared by UNESCO.



KANDY

Kandy which is a World Heritage Site was the last capital of the Sri Lankan Kings. The name "Kandy" conjures visions of splendor and magnificence. Many of the legends, traditions and folklore are still lovingly kept alive. Drive around the Kandy Lake built by the last Sinhala King, Sri Wickrama Rajasinghe in 1798. Visit the Kandy town and Bazaar, the arts & crafts Centre, a gem museum and a lapidary. Also visit the Temple of the Tooth Relic in Kandy.



SIGIRIYA

As one of nature's magnificent creations in Sri Lanka, Sigiriya rock rises abruptly from all sides to a height of 600 ft. Any visitor to Sri Lanka considers it as one of the most memorable places of interest. It is known to have been a fortress kingdom used by King Kassapa.

NUWARAELIYA

Situated in the central highlands of the island, Nuwaraeliya is also known as "Little England" due to the cold climate, endless gardens of flowers and strawberries along with vegetables, and colonial style buildings and holiday homes. The salubrious climes are a contrast from the humid heat in the lowlands. The breathtaking views of the valleys, and mountain ranges as well as the lush greenery make Nuwaraeliya one of the most visited places by local and foreign tourists alike.

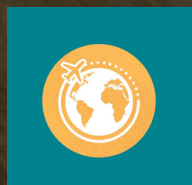


Beaches
